

CINAHL Highlights

CINAHL Headings – thesaurus to the terms used to index articles in CINAHL

Sign In - You can sign in into CINAHL. This will save your any citations in your folder and you can save your searches. You can search CINAHL without signing in but once you exit CINAHL everything will disappear.

Folder – Where you put the citations you would like to print, email, save or export to RefWorks

Published Date – Type in the year range you would like to limit your search. For example, 2009- 2014. You do not have to put in the months.

English Language – Check off this box. Otherwise you will have articles from other languages. The citation will be in English but the actual article will be in the language indicate.
