


## STAT!Ref



Make the following selections to get to STAT!Ref

1. Click on HSL Databases listed under Research Tools




2. Then click on STAT!Ref from the E-book Packages list on the right side of the screen.


**BN students will need their MUN login ID (my.mun account) to access STAT!Ref from home.** Everyone can access STAT!Ref from the computer lab without the MUN login ID.

You may be asked to accept the terms, select accept terms.

You can search STAT!Ref several different ways. You can enter your search terms in the search box (see #1 arrow) and search all of the books.



You can select certain books to search. Enter your search term in the search box and click the search button. Then on the left side you will see 'Custom Title Set'. When you click on that a menu box will appear. Then you can select the books you want to search by clicking the box next to the book title and then click on the save icon (see arrows in picture).



Finally, you can search through a book by clicking on the book title.
